
Job title: Miniroos Game Day Coordinator

Hours: 2-3 per week (including time at Nesbitt Park on game days for some of each Saturday morning)

Location: Some from home Saturday mornings at Nesbitt

Works closely with: Miniroos Coordinator; Set Up Coordinator Miniroos Game Leader Coordinator



Ensure the smooth running of Miniroos home games at Nesbitt Park, arranging and communicating with volunteer teams and ensuring all is in order at the ground each Saturday. Suitable for two people to share the role, to share game day duties.

Key responsibilities & duties

- Work with the Miniroos Coordinator as a support person for game day related tasks.
- Ensures the volunteer roster is ready, correct for each week, and communicated to all teams. Send out reminders to teams. (Note that there is currently a volunteer who builds the roster at the start of each season).
- Manage the required game day equipment and information resources –
 update the game day folder information, check that all resources are present each week
- Help Duty Officer volunteers to become familiar with the role requirements at the ground, particularly important for new volunteers and early in the season
- Assist the Miniroos Game Leader Coordinator in managing any issues that arise on game day
- Promote the quality of KSFCs Miniroos and parent's experience at Nesbitt
 Park. Identify and implement improvements that can be made.
